



Paradox™

OBJECTIVE

Be the first player to line 4 of your same color balls in a vertical, horizontal, or diagonal row. However, as each move is made in conjunction with an opponent's ball, don't inadvertently help them create their line!

GAME PREPARATION

Place 18 balls around the perimeter of the playing board, alternating colors. Position the remaining balls as shown (Fig. 1).

GAME PLAY

Each player chooses a color. The first player selects one of their own balls AND an adjoining ball of their opponents.

The two balls are then moved together as a single unit, one space horizontally, vertically or diagonally, in which both marbles can move freely (fig. 2). An alternate move is to switch the places of the two adjoining marbles. (see bottom of Fig. 2)

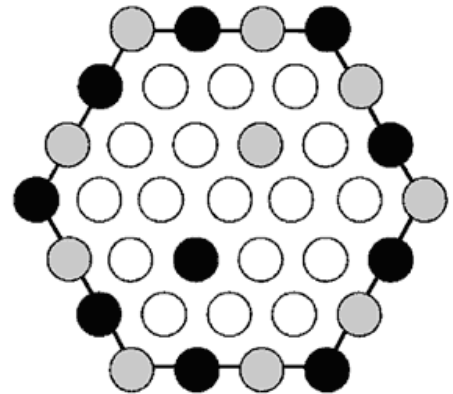

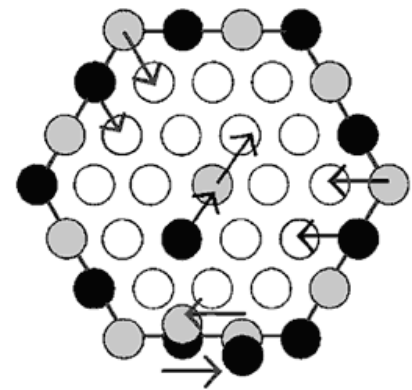

NOTE:

A PLAYER MAY NOT MOVE A BALL INDIVIDUALLY OR WITH ANOTHER BALL OF THE SAME COLOR.
A PLAYER MAY NOT MAKE A MOVE WHICH REVERSES THE LAST MOVE MADE.

WINNING

The first player to line up four of their same color balls, wins.

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
