

The Game with No Point to It!

MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

Select a suitable location with approximately 8' of open space. The "toe-line" or throwing distance should be 7' 9 1/4" from the face of the board. The Bull's Eye must be positioned 5' 8" from the floor.

TECHNIQUE

The throwing motion is from your elbow out. Keep your body steady and use only your hand, wrist, and forearm. To throw a dart, bring your forearm slightly back, and with a fluid motion, throw the dart towards the board.

SCORING

Single: scores as number shown

Double: score x 2 Triple: score x 3

Bull's Eye: outer bull = 25 points inner bull = 50 points

Catch-Ring: no score

301-501

The most popular dart game is where each player starts with 301 (or 401, 501 etc.) points. At the end of each player's turn, the sum of the three darts thrown is subtracted from the player's score. The first player to reach exactly zero, wins.

ROUND THE CLOCK

Players try to hit numbers 1 through 20 in sequence. Double and triple zones are treated the same as a single.
