



Inversé™

A skillful game of construction and obstruction.

OBJECT OF THE GAME

To be the last player to position a piece on the board.

GAME PLAY

Decide who goes first. Give each player a set of 5 different colored playing pieces. Taking turns, place one block on the board, staying inside the grid lines and following these rules:

- 1) Pieces of the same color may not be placed in the exact same way. Eg: If Player 1 positions their red piece vertically, Player 2 must position their red piece horizontally or flat (fig. 1). Once positioned, a piece may not be moved.
- 2) Pieces of the same color, and pieces of the same height (fig.2) may not touch surface-to-surface. Corner connections are allowed (fig. 3).
- 3) Pieces may not be stacked on top of one another.

WINNING

The first player who cannot add a piece into play, loses the game. If it is a "tied game", simply play again!

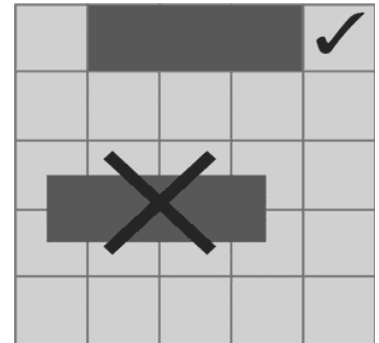

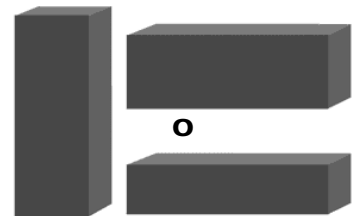

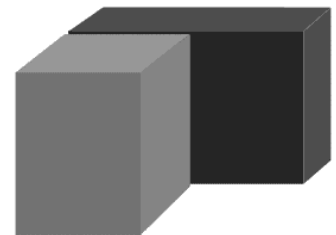
